# **PROJECT INTRODUCTION**

Thank you for your interest in the Campsite Collection App!

Campsite Collector is a critical but simple collector tool that community members and land management agencies can use to gather data on dispersed campsites, view the data in the field and in ARCGIS "Survey123," and report simple summary statistics by camping area and over time. The App is downloaded on your handheld device, such as your cell phone or tablet.

The data that you collect is stored by Chaffee County's GIS department so it can be used to monitor campsites and track changes resulting from site enhancements or impacts from growing use of our public lands. Collected data has already been instrumental for planning and will continue to underpin many strategies and long-term tracking of community success in managing growing outdoor recreation use. Project partners include Chaffee County, Envision Chaffee County, Greater Arkansas River Nature Association (GARNA), US Forest Service – Salida Ranger District and Bureau of Land Management – Royal Gorge Field Office.

The Campsite Collector App is currently available in Chaffee County, Colorado. The App will function without Wi-Fi coverage, as long as you have downloaded it onto your device when Wi-Fi coverage is available. Data measured by Campsite Collector includes a waypoint with latitude and longitude over Google Earth or topographic maps; trash and amount; human waste and amount; fire rings and number; site containment (boulders, fencing or other materials that show campers the appropriate place to camp); spur roads or trails (unofficial trails or roads that originate from the campsite); and any work performed at the site. All this information is used by the Envision Recreation in Balance (hotlink: https://envisionchaffeecounty.org/recreation-in-balance/) initiative and the involved public land agencies to inform our Community Recreation and Resource Protection Plan.

Following are directions for downloading the App onto your device and using the App to collect data and record any site enhancements that you choose to report or complete. Thanks again for contributing to the sustainable management of Chaffee County's public lands!

# **PROJECT DEFINITIONS**

#### Red Dots on Maps

Visible on the default online and offline maps are campsite locations previously collected with the RIMS application.

#### New Survey

Survey choice used when campsite location does not fall on top of one of the red dots or previously collected campsites on the map

#### Re Survey

Survey choice used when campsite location falls on top of one of the red dots or previously collected campsites on the map

#### Action

There are actions that can be undertaken by volunteers under their own discretion and actions that can only be taken with agency approval. The first action question asks, "What actions are required?" This question flags sites for agency action.

#### Non-system Routes and Social Trails

Routes and trails that are user-created, not signed, not maintained by a land management agency, and generally dead end into a campsite.

#### Non-sytem Spur Road

Roads that are user-created, not signed, not maintained by a land management agency, and generally dead end into a campsite.

#### Containment

Campsite containment is a campsite management strategy that adds a barrier to the perimeter of the acceptable campsite. Barriers may be boulders, fencing including buck and rail, and natural surroundings such as dense forest.

## SURVEY DOWNLOAD

#### **ESRI SURVEY123**

Survey123 is an ESRI ArcGIS mobile application that is designed to collect data in the field using a mobile phone or tablet. An internet connection is necessary to download the Survey123 mobile application, but is not necessary for collecting data in the field. Before proceeding with this training document or going out in the field to collect data on dispersed campsites please follow the steps below.

Please note, the Survey123 app and Chaffee County Collector app require at least 1.5 GB to install on a mobile phone. Tap the QR code button in the search tab on the My Survey123 home-screen and scan the QR code to the right to download the Campsite Collector Survey.

To ensure location accuracy and photo capability, ensure that you allow Survey123 access to your Location and Camera in your phone's settings. To access these settings on an iOS phone click on Settings > Survey123 (pictures below) on an Android phone click on Settings > Apps > Survey123 > Permissions.

Once you have successfully downloaded the Chaffee County Campsite Collector survey, adjusted the survey's and your phone's settings you are ready to go out in the field and collect data.

## INITIAL SURVEY QUESTIONS

Most of the questions have hints affiliated with them. Please read hints fully before answering the questions.





- 1. THE DATE IS SET AUTOMATICALLY.
- 2. PLEASE ENTER YOUR FIRST AND LAST NAME AS NOTED
- 3. IF YOUR SITE HAS A PREVIOUS NAME YOU WILL BE ABLE TO ENTER IT IF YOU ANSWER "YES"
- 1. SURVEY123 WILL AUTOMATICALLY CAPTURE YOUR LOCATION. TO OPEN A LARGER MAP CLICK ON THE MAP

Please note, when you are offline the small location map will not be shown.

2. THE TYPE OF SURVEY SELECTED WILL BE BASED ON THE LOCATION FROM THE PREVIOUS QUESTION

### LOCATION QUESTION LARGER MAP

By default a satellite map is opened. The red points on the map represent sites that were collected using RIMS.

Please note, you can pan in and out and scroll around the map using your fingers. Please zoom in to the map if you are unsure if your location is on top of a red point.



If your phone has service you will be able to select from a number of default Esri basemaps and Campsite Collector specific basemaps. Surveys with a .tpk after their name are for offline usage. You can freely choose any of these maps.

## OFFLINE LOCATION QUESTION LARGER MAP

If you do not have cell service you can still capture your location using your cell phone's GPS and the spatially referenced tile packages loaded with the survey.



Tile packages are spatially referenced images. All the tile packages included in the survey are clipped to the immediate study area, which is the reason for the gray margins. To keep file sizes down the tile packages included are medium resolution and will become more blurred as you zoom in. You do not need to upload these offline maps manually, they are included when you download the survey.

1. PHONE IS OFFLINE

2. LOCATION ON SPATIALLY REFERENCED TILE LAYER MAP



If you do not have cell service you are only presented with the two tile packages for offline use. You can choose any of these maps to use while offline.

### 5 SURVEY TYPE SELECTION

If you do not have cell service you can still capture your location using your cell phone's GPS and the spatially referenced tile packages loaded with the survey.



If your location is not on top of a previously collected site or red point you are conducting a new survey. If your location is on top of previously collected site you are conducting a re survey. If you are unsure that is ok as the project team will be doing quality control during the data analysis phase.

If you are simply conducing an action select action.

1. SELECT THE APPROPRIATE SURVEY TYPE TO BE DIRECTED TO THAT SURVEY'S SPECIFIC QUESTIONS.

## NEW AND RE SURVEY

Both the new and resurvey survey questions are the same within the app, though the are presented differently when the data is analyzed by the project team. Please follow these steps for both.

- 1. DISPLAY OF THE TYPE OF SURVEY BEING CONDUCTED
- 2. CLICK ON THE ARROW TO EXPAND THE SITE AREA QUESTION
- 3. CLICK ON THE MAP ICON TO OPEN THE SITE AREA
- 1. LOCATION OF PHONE BASED ON GPS
- 2. ACCURACY OF PHONE LOCATION, IN THIS EXAMPLE THE PHONE'S ACCURACY IS + OR 6.4M.
- Hint. The accuracy will increase the longer you let it settle.

## 2 SITE AREA CAPTURE

The Site Are Capture location will allow you to draw a polygon around the campsite to determine the area of the campsite.



- 1. BEFORE STARTING, ZOOM INTO YOUR LOCATION. THE MAP WILL BECOME BLURRIER TO MORE YOU ZOOM IN
- 2. WHEN YOU ARE HAPPY WITH YOUR ZOOM LEVEL, CLICK ON THE CAPTURE VERTEX BUTTON TO BEGIN TRACING THE CAMPSITE

Please note, you can pan in and out and scroll around the map using your fingers. Once you click on the Capture Vertex Button you will have to use the "+" and "-" navigation options on the side of the map.



DRAWING CAMPSITE POLYGON BY TRACING THE BOUNDARIES ON YOUR SCREEN

- 1. CLICK ON THE CROSSHAIR BUTTON TO BRING UP THE LARGE BLACK CROSSHAIR ON THE SCREEN
- 2. WHEN THE CROSSHAIR BUTTON IS PRESSED A LARGE CROSSHAIR WILL APPEAR ON THE MAP

## 2 SITE AREA CAPTURE



- 1. USE YOUR FINGERS TO MOVE THE CROSSHAIR TO LOCATIONS AT THE PERIMETER OF THE CAMPSITE
- 2. WHEN YOU HAVE THE CROSSHAIR PLACED ON AN APPROPRIATE LOCATION AROUND THE PERIMETER, PRESS THE ADD VERTEX BUTTON THIS WILL AUTOMATICALLY PLACE AND CONNECT ALL THE POINTS PLACED AROUND THE PERIMETER
- 3. ONCE YOU ARE HAPPY WITH THE PERIMETER, CLICK ON THE COMPLETE POLYGON BUTTON

DRAWING CAMPSITE POLYGON BY WALKING THE PERIMETER OF THE CAMPSITE

- 2. WALK THE PERIMETER BOUNDARIES OF THE CAMPSITE, THE CROSSHAIR ICON REPRESENTS THE LOCATION OF YOUR PHONE

- 2. THE ESTIMATED SITE SIZE QUESTION WILL AUTOMATI-CALLY BE POPULATED BASED ON THE POLYGON THAT WAS DRAWN USING THE SITE AREA QUESTION

## $\mathbf{3}$ SURVEY CONTINUED AND SPUR ROADS

Once the site area is captured, please proceed with the survey.



MOST OF THE QUESTIONS IN THE SURVEY CONSIST OF SELECT ONE OR SELECT ALL THAT APPLY ANSWERS, IN ORDER TO TRACK THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TRASH PRES-ENT, THIS QUESTION WILL INVOLVE ESTIMATING THE TOTAL AMOUNT BASED ON THE GIVEN VALUES



The United States Forest Service (USFS) and Bureau of Land Management (BLM) are interested in identifying sites that are accessed with a non-system spur road. If the site is accessed from a non-system spur road please follow the next steps to capture the location and length.

1. CLICK ON THE MAP ICON TO CAPTURE THE LOCATION AND LENGTH OF THE NON-SYSTEM SPUR ROAD

When survey results are submitted you will receive a confirmation message.





1. CLICK TO SAVE SURVEY RESULTS TO YOUR OUTBOX

Please note, you can collect multiple surveys while offline. Make sure you save each new offline survey to your outbox.

Please note, when you return to service, please close the app and reopen it. Sometimes, especially if pictures are attached, the survey will give an error message when submitting surveys collected while offline.

When survey(s) results are submitted you will receive a confirmation message.

When the survey is submitted while online or placed in the inbox if offline, you can press the "Collect" button to collect additional site surveys.
